What is an Airport Master Plan?

An Airport Master Plan is a strategic study to determine long-term development plans for an airport, including the type, extent, and schedule of development needed to meet forecasted needs. It establishes guidelines for efficient airport development aligned with local, state, and national goals.

The plan provides a 20-year development program to create a safe, efficient, economical, and environmentally responsible airport facility. It ensures the airport can meet future aviation demand, achieve TRI's development goals, and add public value for the Tri-Cities region and the aeronautical community.

The final document is crucial for coordination between TRI and the FAA, depicting existing facilities and planned development initiatives to meet capital improvement needs.
